CAREER EXPLORATION PROGRAM

WHAT IS IT?

The Career Exploration Program at Porter and Chester Institute offers high school students a glimpse into each of our programs... kind of a “day in the life.”



WHEN?

Either 2 or 4 days per week (generally your students last class of the day) and 8 weeks long.

WHERE?

Your students visit our campus and experience our instructors, classrooms, and industry modeled-labs

HOW?

Your students spend several days shadowing each program individually.

WHY?

Your students gain exposure to each career and insight to what it's about.

- ▶ Strict attendance required
- ▶ Student must adhere to all PCI policies and procedures
- ▶ Student provides own transportation
- ▶ Class size is limited
- ▶ Each high school awards the credit to their student
- ▶ Student is awarded a certificate of completion (non-credit)
- ▶ Student is awarded the High School Partnership Grant (expires 10/31 of that year)
